

## **Monthly Maintenance Check Procedure for the Zoll AED Plus**

Check for the green check (✓) in the status indicator window showing that the AED Plus is ready to use.
Verify that electrodes pads are within their expiration date.
Verify that batteries are within their expiration date. Typically 5 years from date of installation.
Note: there is not an expiration date printed on the batteries. Only the installation date as noted on the exterior of the case.
Verify that electrodes and cables are undamaged and properly connected to the AED.
Verify that supplies are available for use (razor, mask, gloves, extra batteries)
Verify that the unit is clean, undamaged and free from excessive wear. Contact OEHS at 801-581-6590 to report damage.
Turn the AED on and off to verify function. The green check ( $\checkmark$ ) should remain lit in the status indicator window.
Record the monthly inspection on the inspection tag attached to the AED unit.

Report use of the AED to OEHS at 801-581-6590 as soon after the use as possible, OEHS will re-supply the AED.
